	resemblance to existing footwear designs!						
	If you could go anywhere on vacation, where would you go? Illustrate or collage						
your destination. Use <b>color</b> . A collage by definition features more than or image. No Dead Space!							
Draw your first name, last name, or initials using graffiti styled bubble							
16	letters. Use at least 3 colors and colored pencils or markers. Fill the page!						
	Create a drawing of a tool (flashlight, hammer, pliers, etc) from observation; make						
17	your drawing at least 5x5". Put the tool in an unusual setting and out of scale (too						
	big or too small). For example: A flashlight being used as a spotlight by a rockband						
	of insects. Use <b>colored pencil</b> .						
	Draw a cartoon of an anthropomorphic food – Use colored pencil. Fill the page						
18	and add a caption to your creation.						
	Create an ambigram (a word that is another word when viewed upside down). Try						
19	to use a <b>pallindrome</b> (a word or phrase that is the same backwards as forward).						
	Look online for examples but do not copy them! Use block letters. Fill the page.						
	If you could be a superhero/villain, what would your superpower be? Create a						
20	sketch or collage a super-you and describe your powers and your reason for being						
	in a sentence or two. Use <b>color</b> .
