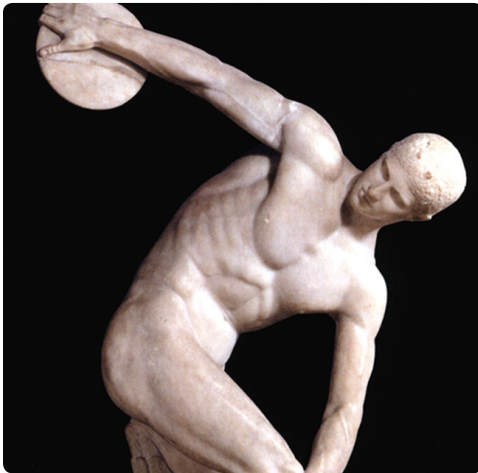

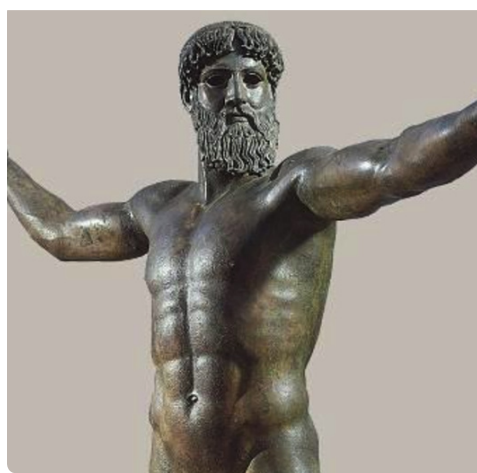
**#2 | Exekias | Achilles and Ajax Playing Dice**

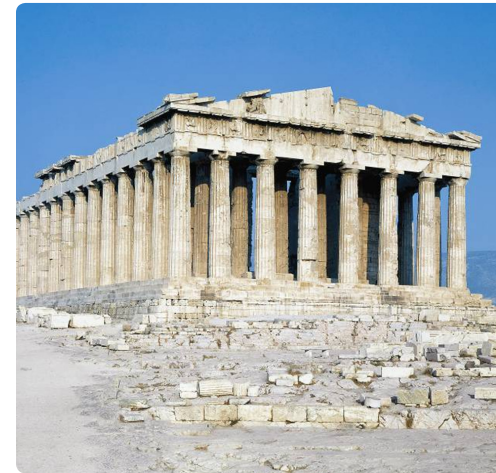
**#3 | Niobid Painter | Musical Scene**

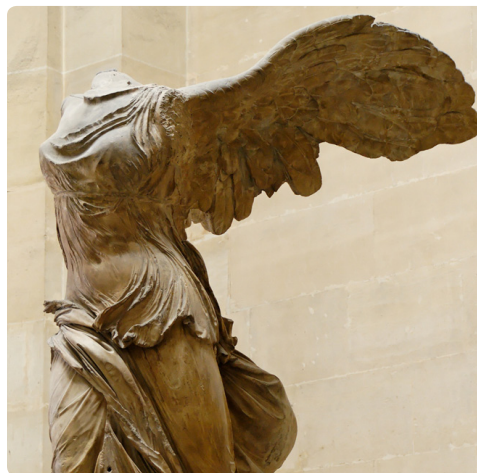
**#5 | Artemision Bronze (Zeus or Poseidon)**

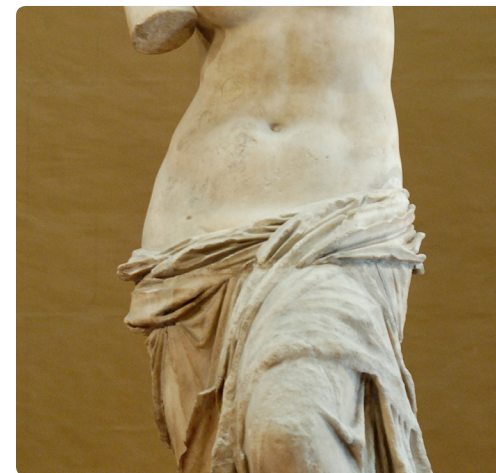
**#6 | Iktinos and Kallikrates | Parthenon**

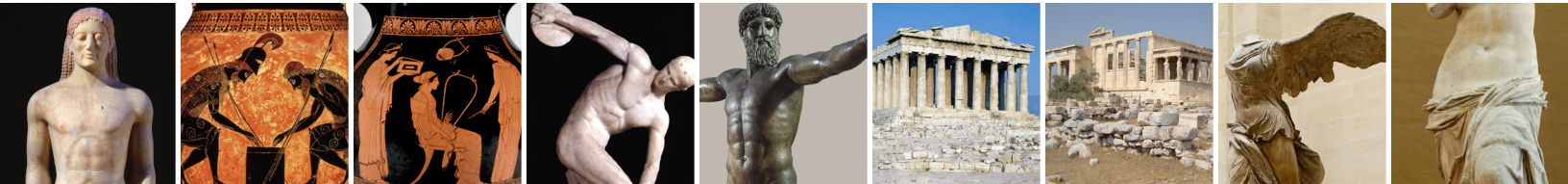
