Mosaic Art

Step 1: Draw a simple outline onto paper using pencil

Step 2: Go over the pencil with thick sharpie marker (black)

*Keep the design simple. The more complex the drawing is the more difficult it will be to fill in.

Step 3: Cut up pieces of paper into different sized squares

- * The largest square should be no larger than your toe nail
- * You can use plain construction paper or you can try scrapbooking paper with colourful patterns



Step 4: Before you begin filling in a section with tiles, colour it completely with a sharpie marker.

* Only fill in one section at a time



Step 5: Apply a small section of adhesive (Mod Podge works really well).




Step 6: Place the tiles onto the adhesive. You can cut pieces to fit into small or awkward shaped spaces.



Step 7: Once the section is filled with tiles. Seal it by covering it with a thin layer of adhesive (Mod Podge or

white glue)



The adhesive will dry clear and leave a glossy finish



Step 8: Repeat the process for each section until the whole page is filled with tiles
