
GFTTING STARTED

When creating a new document, you'll want to make sure your units are set to inches.


Don't forget to set your margins (.5 inch margins are common because most in-house printers won't print to the edge of a page). If you are planning to print professionally (or off the edge of your paper), you'll want to set the bleed to .125 in.

WORKSPACE SETUP

Make sure (at least) the items below are checked. They'll help you design a bit more easily.







USEFUL TIPS

Select multiple objects at once: Hold shift and click desired objects OR Click and drag over all desired objects (be sure the entire object is within the selection).

Unselect an object: Click outside of the object in a blank spot on your page.

Group your objects: Select all items you'd like to group, right click and choose "group." This will treat the objects as one until ungrouped.

Scale objects proportionally: Hold control (command on mac) while dragging out the corner of an object frame.

Affect an image or text: Double click on an image or text frame in order to access the image or text inside.

Extra options: Right click on an object to see additional options specific to that object.

Move your page: Hit the space bar once (the cursor will become a hand) and you can move the page without affecting objects. (Space again to escape.)


Move objects in a straight line: Hold control (command on mac) while dragging an object to move it in a straight horizontal or vertical lign.

Create a guideline: Click on a vertical or horizontal ruler and drag it to the desired location. (Not visible on prints; drag off page to delete.)




OBJECT PROPERTIES




You can also use the "edit text" tool to modify bigger blocks of type.




- 2. Object Fill Color
