- 3. TEACHER WILL GO OVER OBJECTIVES
- 4. STAY FOCUSED EVEN IF YOU SIT WITH FRIENDS OR LISTEN TO MUSIC
 - 5. CLEAN UP 10 MIN BEFORE END OF CLASS
 - 6. WASH ANYTHING THAT YOU GET DIRTY
 - 7. MAKE SURE YOUR PROJECT HAS YOUR NAME ON IT
 - 8. PLACE YOUR ART IN YOUR DRAW
 - 9. DO NOT TALK WHILE TEACHER IS TALKING
- 10. STAY SEATED UNLESS YOU HAVE PERMISSION TO DO OTHERWISE
- 11. THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS "I CAN'T," THERE IS ONLY "I HAVE SOMETHING NEW TO LEARN"
- 12. YOU WILL RECEIVE A RUBRIC AT THE START OF EACH PROJECT AND A GRADE WILL BE EARNED
