Drawing I: SURREALISM in PERSPECTIVE

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS:

- Students will be creating a drawing of an interior space in one-point perspective including technical skill of vanishing points, horizon lines, and use of rulers.
- Full use of VALUE SCALE...using pen and ink techniques learned (hatching, cross-hatching, stippling, etc.)
- Interesting/complete composition with details drawn to scale and correct perspective (lockers, floor, lights, posters, etc.) to create a feeling of depth)
- Creative use of Surrealism style in drawing to create and transform conventional/ordinary space into something unconventional by scale, levitation (floating), juxtaposition of objects (impossible combinations), dislocation (moving object to unusual environment), transformation (change objects from original state), and unusual proportion (size relation/change).
